

CHICKY MAKE-DO

Wool Pincushion

(Approx. 8 – 9 inches tall)

Kit includes: glass candlestick, yellow wool for Chick, wool strips for tail feathers, red wool for Heart, small muslin fabric square for emery bag, emery sand, 2 black Eye beads, pre-stamped manila tag, 4 inch wood dowel, complete instructions, pattern & photo. (*Original Design by Diane Daniels*)

STUDENT'S SUPPLY LIST: (PLEASE BRING WITH YOU TO CLASS!)

1. Spool of natural linen thread (or quilt weight or buttonhole twist thread) to dangle the emery heart from, tie on the tiny buttons and attach the Chick to the wood dowel
2. Spool of black (quilt weight or buttonhole twist thread) to sew on Chick's eyes
3. Spool of red and yellow or lt. beige sewing thread to sew the red Heart & yellow Chick
4. Any inexpensive thread for basting
5. 1 Skein of #420 gold floss (or equivalent)
6. #24 or #26 Tapestry Needle (large eye, thin needle w/ blunt end)
7. Regular Sewing Needle
8. Straight Pins
9. (5) - tiny buttons, creamy/yellow to chick yellow in color (1/4" to 1/2" in size) **Vintage buttons like Bakelite are wonderful if you can find them!*
10. Polyester fiberfill stuffing
11. Stuffing tool (hemostat or chopstick)
12. Silicone, Liquid Nails or Cement Glue (to "fix" the dowel to candlestick)
13. Plastic clear glitter sprinkles to add a "texturing" to the candlestick
14. Bottle of powdered Cinnamon (for candlestick)
15. Small bottle Dark Brown liquid acrylic paint (like Folk Art brand found at Michael's Craft store)
16. Inexpensive paint brush or sponge brush
17. Krylon Matte Spray Finish (found at any Michael's Craft store)
18. Reynolds Plastic-coated Freezer Paper or Template Plastic, about 12 inch square piece
19. Hot Glue Gun & Glue Sticks
20. Personal Hair Dryer (with an extension cord if you have one)
21. Sewing machine for constructing the Chick
