

Anything Goes Star Tessellation

Supply List

1. 100 Plus different fabrics cut 2” for a Large Lap Quilt. If using fat quarters, cut (2) strips; otherwise cut 1 strip the full width from each fabric. You will not use all the strips in the workshop unless you REALLY speed sew, so cut as many as possible. No need to worry about how many light or dark or what color it is, because anything goes. You can even cut more than one strip from each fabric. Just make sure you have at least 20 or so for variety. I cut fabric from everything I was currently working on and anything that came into the house, next I cut from my stash.
2. “Easy Angle” tool by EZ. Any size, I think it comes in three sizes now. I like the small one.
3. Basic sewing supplies, gray and beige thread or any thread that you want to use up, scissors, rotary cutting supplies, rotary ruler (6” x 24”), sewing machine, safety pins (1” long), straight pins, extension cord and pencil.
4. Batting – Full size or appropriate to how big you made the top.
5. Backing Fabric – 5 or more yards or big enough to be the back
6. Border Fabric – 1 yard
7. Vibrant quilting thread

Items 1-3 needed for class and items 4-7 needed to finish bed quilt. We will need to do a little pressing, if you have a small iron and ironing pad please bring it.

From each strip cut: four 5" and four 3 ½", straight pin all (8) pieces together as a group. Make as many sets as possible before class.
