

Painted Landscapes 101

- Sewing Machine** - in good working order - don't forget the foot pedal & cord
- Free motion/darning foot**
- Walking Foot** (optional) - but great to have with this project!
- Thread - 100% cotton**
 - 1 spool of each: black, white & neutral (gray, taupe, etc.) & "play thread" in different colors to accent your landscapes**
- Bobbins** - (fill 1 bobbin from the black, white & neutral thread)
- Machine Needles** -
 - 80/12 Jeans/Denim needles**
 - 75/11 & 90/14 Embroidery needles** (combo packet available)
- Rotary Cutting Equipment: Ruler, Mat & Cutter**
- Freezer Paper** (Reynold's Brand Suggested)
- Roll of Paper Towels** (for clean up purposes)
- Spray Bottle**: nothing fancy, just something that will spray water
- Basic sewing kit**: straight pins, fabric scissors, paper scissors, seam ripper, pencils, pencil sharpener & note pad
- Fabric - 100% cotton - Two sets of the following:**
 - ½ - 1 yard border fabric**
 - ½ Inner Border Fabric** - black or color to match the border fabric (choose a solid or tone on tone)
 - 1 yard backing fabric**

Note: You may opt to bring a few sets of border/backing fabric. You won't know what color you will need until the painting is complete. If you are fortunate to be in a fabric shop for this class you may choose to purchase fabric once your painting is finished!

- \$8 Kit Fee:** payable to instructor the day of class (includes all paints & materials, PFD fabric, batting, and misc. items)

In order to utilize class time, and as a courtesy to classmates, come with all necessary supplies and be prepared to begin to sew at the scheduled class time.
