(using the Square in a Square ruler)
approx. 45 x 50

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Supply List

Fabric:

Main fabric(s) (purples in class sample): need a total of 1 1/2 yds. (minimum) of various fabrics – cut some of each width strips from various fabrics. You may want to have extra strips cut if using a group of fabrics to allow for choices as you make the blocks. You can also use a single fabric here (choose either a light or dark).

Background fabric (light blue in class sample): need a total of 1 1/2 yds. You may also use more than one background fabric if you like, just cut strips from a variety of fabrics similar in value. You can also use a single fabric here (use a value opposite of what you choose for the main fabric).

For borders (background fabric, light blue in sample), 1 yd (can use several fabrics)

For accent borders & binding (main fabric, purples in sample), 3/4 yd (can use several fabrics)

Backing, 3 yds

Borders, binding and backing are personal preference and do not need to be purchased or cut before class. The above list will finish your quilt like the class sample.

NOTE: Before class, please cut strips as per the Pre-Class Preparation Instructions.

Other Supplies:

- Square in a Square ruler – this is a specific quilting tool designed by Jodi Barrows and **you must have one for this class**. It is available at your local quilt show or online from www.squareinasquare.com (but, please shop locally whenever possible!!) If you are unsure as to what this tool is, or cannot locate one, contact Kim (she may be able to have a few to sell for the class.)
- Sewing machine in good working condition – will need 1/4" foot or some other method to ensure accurate 1/4" seam
- 45mm or 60 mm Rotary cutter (put in a new blade!!), mat, 6 x 24 and 6 x 12 rulers (NOTE: a rotating cutting mat would be helpful, but not required)
- Basic sewing supplies – pins, thread, scissors, etc.
- Batting (not needed during class)
