Pre-Class Preparation Instructions

Fabric should be washed & pressed, preferably with a spray starch or sizing (I really like a product called "Mary Ellen's Best Press"). Before class, please cut strips as listed and organize them by **letter**, the reference is to a part of a block in the quilt (it will make sense in class):

For Quilt Blocks:

Light fabric, 2 1/4 yds

- A** – (2) strips cut 3 3/8" wide
- D** – (8) strips cut 2 1/2" wide
- G** – (17) strips cut 2 1/2" wide

(Yes, this means cut a total of (25) light strips at 2 1/2" wide, then separate into 2 groups by letter)

Medium fabric, 1 yd

- B** – (10) strips cut 2 1/4" wide
- C** – (2) strips cut 4" wide

Dark fabric, 1 1/2 yds

- E** – (10) strips cut 3 1/4" wide
- F** – (4) strips cut 4" wide

Additional fabric (will complete quilt in same way as class sample):

- Narrow inner border, 1/3 yd, cut (5) strips at 2" wide
- Outer border, 1 yd, cut (6) strips at 5 1/2" wide
- Binding, 1/2 yd, cut (7) strips at 2 1/2" wide

All strips are cut selvage to selvage. Bring cut strips and any remaining uncut fabric from the supply list (provided separately) to class. I use plastic zipper bags to organize strips (**write the letter on bag**).

Please cut strips as accurately as possible – it does make a difference.
