12 Block Coffee Filter Fan Quilt
 Quilt Size: 24" x 30"



20 Block Coffee Filter Fan Quilt
 Quilt Size: 38" x 44"

All instructions and patterns for the 6" block are supplied. Students will learn paper piecing curved fan blocks, easy applique onto background squares, and my easy magical mitering method. This is not for beginning quilters but is great for the advanced beginner. Must have a good relationship with your sewing machine. All sewing is straight-line sewing. There are NO set-in seams. ALL COFFEE FILTERS ARE SUPPLIED.

Fabric Requirements for top 2 quilts:

3/4 yard background for blocks (any color)

***EACH BLOCK REQUIRES (4) 2-1/2" X 5-1/2" STRIPS AND ONE 2-1/2" SQUARE FROM YOUR STASH

OR select a wide variety of fat eighths or fat quarters.

1 yard lightweight interfacing (NOT FUSIBLE)

for sewing and turning under the curved fan edge

1/4 yard for inner border (top 2 quilts)

1/2 yard EACH of two contrasting prints for borders and binding

Add-a-Quarter ruler (6" or 12")

Thread to top stitch the fans to backgrounds

NOTE: for all 3 quilts I used a multi-colored variegated

Neutral thread for sewing; freezer paper;

scissors and basic sewing supplies

PRECUTTING YOUR STRIPS GIVES YOU A RUNNING HEAD START

Green Fan Variation: Block Size is 12" →

Quilt Size: 43" x 58"

(96) 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips in assorted colors and prints

(20) 3" squares in assorted colors and prints

3/4 yard lime green for block background (or any color)

1/4 yard black print for attic window sashings

1/4 yard hot pink print for attic window sashings

1/2 yard for thin inner sashings

1/2 yard navy for 9-patches and binding

1 yard border print
