3 Hour Workshop



Lap Sized Quilt
Block Size: 10"
Quilt Center: 40" x 50"
With borders = 54" x 64"



Table Runner
Block Size: 10"
Quilt Center: 20" x 40"
With borders = 28" x 48"

This is another "no template" quilt using only pre-cut 10-1/2" squares. (If you have a stack of 10" squares, they will also work with this particular pattern.) Begin with stacks of squares and a rotary cutter, we will slice and shuffle our stacks, sew them together with skinny strips to simulate stained glass. No bias edges, no funky cutting techniques – just straight cuts and easy sewing. A set of 4 squares will yield 4 blocks. Block size is approximately 10" finished.

Fabric Requirements for quilt on left:

- (20) 10" OR 10-1/2" squares (batiks work well, but bring whatever fabric you desire)
- 1/2 yard fabric for thin strip inserts (mine is a black and white batik)
- 1-1/2 yards for outer border and binding

Fabric Requirements for smaller quilt available on request

12-1/2" square acrylic ruler AND rectangular 6" x 24" (or 6" x 12") ruler; rotary cutter & mat
Neutral thread for sewing and basic sewing supplies
Sewing machine in good working order. DO NOT BRING A BRAND NEW MACHINE YOU'VE NEVER SEWN WITH BEFORE!!!
