SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- ..Pattern – Geese in the Fields by Far Flung Quilts (Pattern available from Easy As Pie Designs \$8 no shipping fee)
- ..Sewing Machine – one you are familiar with and bring back if possible
- ..Rotary Cutter, board, and ruler
- ..Basic sewing supplies (seam ripper, pins, extra sewing machine needles, etc.)
- ..Mechanical pencil works very well for drawing a line down the middle of your squares. If you have dark fabric you will need to bring a marking tool that you can see the line on your fabric squares.
- ..Thread to coordinate with your fabrics
- ..1/4" foot for machine helpful
- *not needed if your needle moves from side to side on your sewing machine

FABRIC NEEDED:

- ..13 Fat Quarters – these fabrics make up the "geese" and "fields" (Big 9 1/2" squares)
- ..2 1/2 yards background fabric
- *I used 5 – 1/2 yards of different backgrounds to give it a scrappier look. I also used flannels for my quilt. I would strongly suggest you pre-wash flannels before cutting as they shrink differently depending a fabric company.

- ..5 yards Backing Fabric
- ..3/4 yards Binding Fabric
- ..Ott light or any desk light is helpful but optional
