FABRIC:

Assorted 8 inch squares*

The display quilt uses 88 squares (8 across x 11 down).
You can use any number you wish.

The fabrics I used in this quilt come from a “line.” I used between 17-19 different prints (reds, greens, golds, browns). Of course, you certainly can use fewer prints and limit the color palette. I’ve seen this in just 2 colors and it was beautiful (blues & yellows) This project also works well with a “totally scrappy” look (many colors, many prints). The choice is yours. What a great way to use those leftovers since you don’t need specific yardage. You can make it as big or as small as you wish.

I haven’t given you yardage for borders, as I think borders need to be chosen once the quilt body is complete. Anyway, I don’t know how big you’re going to make this! But, I’m sure you’ll love this technique and won’t be satisfied with a “table runner!!”

TOOLS:

Sewing machine with ¼” foot

Extension cord

Neutral thread

Rotary cutter, small mat, ruler (6” or 6 ½” x 12” works well) or anything over 12”,
but less than 24”

Spray sizing

Seam ripper (which I’m sure you won’t use!)

Scissors
