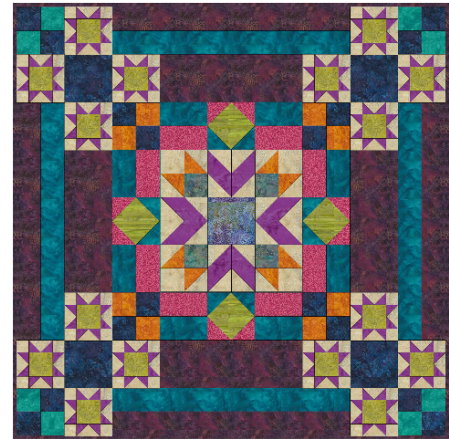


Star Struck

54" x 54"

This supply list is written a little differently than what you may be used to. I hope that writing it this way makes it easier for you to identify which fabrics go where in the quilt.



Basic quilting supplies - neutral color cotton thread for piecing on top and in bobbin, rotary cutter, square ruler, rotary mat, straight pins, (optional) 60" square of batting to use as design wall, duct tape for design wall, Angler II (if you can't find one, I will have them for sale in class), or your favorite fabric marking tool, scissors.

Pattern – Star Struck by Linda J. Hahn of Frog Hollow Designs

Fabrics – I always heavily starch my fabrics before beginning (but the choice is yours)

- A ¼ yard (Dark Teal)
- B ¼ yard (Dark Pink)
- C ¼ yard (Green #1)
- D 1/3 yard (Medium Navy)
- E 1 ¼ yards (Purple #1)
- F ¼ yard (Medium Orange)
- G 2/3 yard (Purple #2)
- H ½ yard (Medium Teal)
- J ¼ yard (Tan #1)
- K ¼ yard (Green #2)
- L 5/8 yard (Tan #2)
- M ¼ yard (Blue print)

STAR STRUCK Pre-Class Cutting

Square in a Square/Rail Fence (Fabrics A & B)

- (8) 3 ½" squares of each fabric
- (8) 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles

Square in a Square (Fabric C)

- (4) 6 ½" squares

Four Patch/Solid Square (Fabric D)

- (16) 3 ½" squares
- (4) 6 ½" squares

Small Star Points/Four Patch/Center Star (Fabric E)

- (8) 3 ½" squares
- (128) 2" squares
- (4) 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles

Four Patch/Center Star (Fabric F)

- (8) 3 ½" squares
- (4) 4" squares

Border #1 and #3 (Fabric G)

- (4) 30 ½" x 3 ½" strips
- (4) 18 ½" x 6 ½" strips

Border #2 (Fabric H)

- (4) 30 ½" x 3 ½" strips

Center Star (Fabric J)

- (4) 3 ½" squares
- (4) 4" squares
- (4) 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles

Small Center Star (Fabric K)

- (16) 3 ½" squares

Small Star/Center Star Points (Fabric L)

- (64) 2" squares
- (64) 2" x 3 ½" rectangles
- (8) 3 ½" squares

Center Star (Fabric M)

- (1) 6 ½" square
- (4) 3 ½" squares
