

Hand Appliqué by Machine

Love the look of Hand Appliqué but just don't have the time for handwork? Try this technique that will make your machine appliqué look as if it was done by hand and only take a fraction of the time too! Learn all about the tricks and tools you need for success. Your quilt will look like you sat for hours and needle-turned by hand each piece!

Supplies:

****Sewing machine with blind hem stitch****

Batting at least 20" square

Scissors (paper and fabric) and pencil

Mono-filament thread

Water-soluble glue stick

Basic sewing supplies; basic rotary cutting supplies, 12 inch square ruler

Light table is nice to have but not necessary.

amounts are generous.

	Fat quarters or large scraps
Bird	2 coordinating blues
Leaves	green
Apples	2 coordinating reds
Branch and stems, inner border	Brown
Background	Fat Quarter: white or cream
Border and binding	Fat Quarters: Coordinating fabric of your choice
Backing Fabric	Fat Quarter or 20" inch square
