61" x73"

You will need:

Sewing machine, 1/4 inch foot, basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, thread...)

Rotary cutter, mat

6x24 inch ruler; 12-1/2" square ruler

15 degree wedge ruler - an absolute must-have for the class - Bethany Reynold's fan Stack-n-Whack ruler is a good choice.

Fabric requirements

20 blocks - quilt finishes 61" x 73"

Background: 2-1/2 yards

Cat fabric:

1. For Scrappy Cats: 30 fat quarters or 1/4 yard cuts.

You will need 6 shades of each color. The class sample uses 5 "cat" colors - red, gold, orange, purple and green.

2. For Two-Toned Cats - 4 yards - Eight 1/2 yard cuts would get you eight shades of one color. For example: blue cats with yellow backgrounds - you will need assorted blues to get the cats to sparkle.

Border and binding: 2 yards

12 blocks - quilt finishes 49" x 61"

Background: 1-3/4 yards

Cat fabric:

1. For Scrappy Cats: 24 fat quarters or 1/4 yard cuts.

You will need 6 shades of each "cat" color. Four different "cat" colors would be sufficient.

2. For Two-Toned Cats - 2-1/4 yards - 1/4 yard cuts would get you nine shades of one color. For example: blue cats with yellow backgrounds - you will need assorted blues to get the cats to sparkle.

Border and binding: 1.75 yards
