

Supply List

Tree of Life Medallion Quilt

Witt Karen
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3 yards chintz for outside border, flower applique on center panel, piecing

1 1/2 yards background fabric for center panel
(match this as close as possible to the background of chintz fabric)

1 yard brown print for tree trunk, piecing

Approximately 4 yards of miscellaneous fabrics for piecing. Reproduction fabrics from the early 19th century should include toiles, chintzes, woodblocks, ramoneurs (small scale dark brown prints), pale double pinks, golds, Prussian blues, greens, turkey reds. You may limit your choices to only a few or use a variety. Be sure to include light, medium, and dark fabrics.

Sewing machine with buttonhole stitch

Steam A Seam Lite™ or other lightweight fusible interfacing -- 2-3 sheets or 1/2 yard

Freezer paper -- approximately 1 yard

Rotary cutter, ruler, cutting mat

Basic sewing supplies

Pencils

Optional -- Easy Angle™ and Companion Angle™ (rotary cutting rulers). Teacher will bring for use in class.
